Strong growth in Q3: revenue up by 10.1%

Annual growth target confirmed: about 7% (excl. impact of international contracts)

- ❑ **Hazardous Waste: capacities fully available**
- ❑ **Non Hazardous Waste: strong and lasting growth**
- ❑ **Upstream activities: buoyant cross-business activities**

At September 30, 2007, consolidated revenue amounted to EUR 275.6 million, a 5.3% increase on proforma revenue for the first nine months of 2006 (EUR 261.7 million).

As expected, growth over the first nine months of 2007 picked up compared with the first half of the year, reflecting the strong business activity recorded in the third quarter, in particular in the waste treatment businesses:

- ❑ Hazardous Industrial Waste treatments benefited from the return of all the facilities to full capacity. The marked growth in activity over the quarter (12.3%) was also boosted by the invoicing that had been postponed in H1 due to the construction of the “direct processes” at the Salaise 2 site;
- ❑ In line with expectations, Non Hazardous Waste activities resumed strong growth (18.5%) over the quarter.

Upstream activities continued to develop in Q3, notably the cross-business activities (global offers, decontamination).

Growth targets confirmed for 2007

Building on the excellent fundamentals of the waste treatment markets, Séché Environnement should be able to pursue its development over the coming months, notably in the waste treatment businesses.

Hazardous Waste treatments are expected to post a typically strong fourth quarter, while the Non Hazardous Waste activities should continue to benefit from the long lasting positive impact of the closure of non-compliant landfill sites.

Due to the large International one-off decontamination contracts invoiced in Q4 2006, Upstream activities will factor in an unfavorable base effect.

Excluding the impact of these one-off contracts, Séché Environnement confirms its organic revenue growth rate of around 7% of consolidated revenue.
