Séché Environnement and Sergies announce the creation of Senergies, a new joint subsidiary specializing in the production of renewable energies

***Senergies** is set to reinforce Séché's growth dynamic
on the green energies market*

Séché Environnement and Sergies have joined forces to found a new joint subsidiary called Senergies, which will produce electricity from renewable energy sources.

The new company, in which Séché Environnement holds a 80% stake, will initially develop a pilot project to extract biogas from Séché Environnement's Vigeant site in the Vienne department of France.

Under this project, the first production unit, with an installed production capacity of 2.8 kW, is scheduled to begin generating electricity from biogas before the end of 2008.

Meanwhile, for the longer term, Senergies is researching further electricity production projects which will make use of other forms of renewable energy.

About Sergies :

Sergies was established in 2001 as a local public-private joint venture, principally for the purpose of constructing and operating decentralized facilities for electricity generation, particularly from renewable energies, and exploiting ways of controlling energy demand.

Sergies is held 85% by SIEEDV, an association of local authorities in the Vienne department of France to develop electricity generation and other facilities, and 15% by various institutional investors (9 % Caisse des Dépôts et Consignations, 4% Crédit Agricole and 2% Société Générale).

In particular, at its Rochereau site in the Vienne department, Sergies operates the first wind farm to have been authorized in the Vienne. department.
