### Stronger activity confirmed in Q3 Full-year revenue target confirmed

- Revenue well up on most perimeters for the 3rd quarter
  - Solid contribution from new perimeters
    - Furia (Italy): +€17.3m
    - Eco (Singapore): +€18.6m
  - Acceleration of organic growth\* in France and abroad
    - France: revenue up +4%.

Solidity of most markets (excluding energy)

Strong contribution from environmental emergency activities

■ International: revenue down -3%

Gradual ramp-up of large-scale. long-term service contracts signed during the summer



### Contributed revenue: +18% Improved organic growth on main perimeters

#### Change in reported revenue in €m




- Non-contributed revenue: €20.5m (vs. €17.8m in Q3 23)
  - IFRIC 12 investments: €2.4m vs. €3.1m
  - TGAP: €18.1m vs. €14.7m
- Contributed revenue: €286.3m (vs. €241.7m in Q3 23)
  - +18.5% (reported data)
  - +1.9% (like-for-like\*)
- Scope effect: +€40.5m
- Limited Forex effect: €(0.6)m vs. €(4.3)m
- Acceleration of organic growth in France in most businesses
- Contrasting trends outside France by subsidiary and region



- Scope effect: €40.5m Furia (+€17.3m); Essac (+€1.2m); Rent-A-Drum (+€3.4m); Eco (+18.6 M€)

  - Europe (excluding Solarca): revenue €18.7m down -3.9%.
  - Southern Africa: revenue €21.2m down 9.1%.
  - AmLat: revenue €10.8m up +1.6%
  - Solarca (Europe and Rest of World): revenue €7.0m up +11.5%





#### Quarterly revenue trends Acceleration of growth in Q3















### Details of "Spot" and "Energy" effects Spot markets: strong recovery in France and abroad Energy" effect: normalization of energy prices






## Change in business mix Solid contribution from Hazard Management and Services



Non-Hazardous Waste Division: revenue €83.0m up+12.7% (reported)
up +2.8% (organic\*)

- Scope effect: +€7.3m (Furia's non-hazardous waste activities + RAD)
- On a like-for-like basis\*
  - France: revenue of €65.5m. down -3.0% (energy effect: -€2.8m)
  - International: revenue of €10.2m up +67.2% (AmLat)


Hazardous Waste Division: revenue €203.3m up +20.8% (reported) up +1.4% (organic\*)


- Scope effect: +33.2 M€ (Furia. Essac. Eco)

  - International: revenue down -11.6% to €47.4m (decline in Circular Economy at Interwaste)



## 9-month contributed revenue: +8% Organic growth penalized by energy and Q1 delay in spot businesses







#### Positive outlook Target confirmed for FY 2024 Revenue

- Continuation of the positive trends seen in Q3 over the coming months
  - France
    - Resilient markets (except Energy impacts in 2024)
    - Good level of activity anticipated in "spot" activities (Remediation. Emergencies. etc.).
  - International:
    - Differentiated trends by region and subsidiary
    - Rise in major Services contracts (Remediation, Total Waste Management ...) particularly in AmLat
- Confirmed revenue target of around €1.120 million for FY 2024
